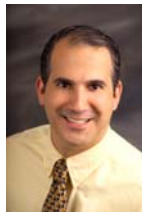
UWGB Interim Chancellor Dr. David Ward will share his thoughts related to current events at UWGB and the UW-System related to education and earnings.
