Our own Tom Milbourn will discuss what is all involved in planning a nightly, live newscast. The details, the logistics, the fun.

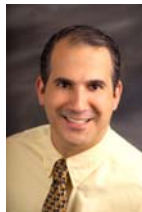
### Club Questionnaire
