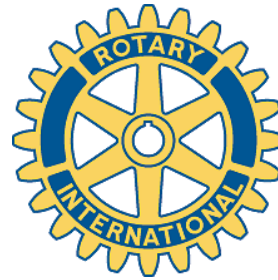

N.E.W. Curative Rehabilitation

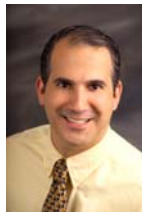
Members of N.E.W. Curative Rehabilitation will present about their organization and services relating to Wraparound and Adult Day Programs.
