Former District Governor John Herlache explains PowerFlour and how it's helped children all over the world with nutrition.

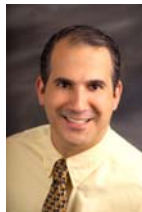
District Conference May 15 – 17, 2009
