### Classification Talks

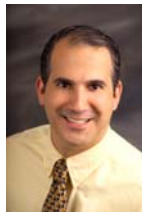
Our meeting will feature Classification Talks from Kari Moody and Gordon Russell. Join us to hear from 2 of our newer members.
