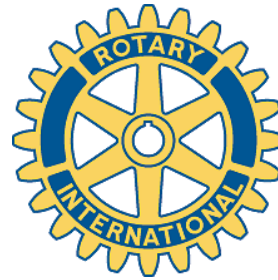

John Jones, formerly of the Green Bay Packers, will provide an enlightening presentation: "The Men's Healthcare Myth" about his health issues.

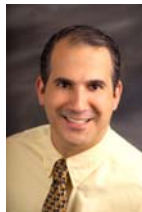
Hygiene Drive: 6/8 & 6/15
