Former District Governor Judy Herlache will share about her National Immunization Day trip to Nigeria. It will be a touching and thought-provoking meeting.

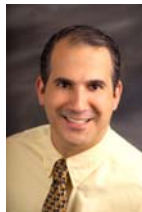
Adult Youth Leadership Award: June 29
