Our presentation will be from Jim Hill of Libertas. Jim will also be receiving our annual Adult Youth Leadership Award in recognition for his excellence with youth.

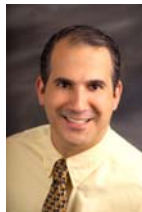
### Welcome to President Barbie
