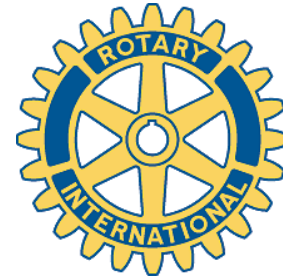

Dear RI Tri District PETS 6220, ShelterBox is responding to Typhoon Morakot after tens of thousands of people have been left stranded in the storm's wake. During the past several days, the storm has passed over the Philippines, Taiwan and mainland China, leaving a trail of destruction. High winds, flooding and mudslides have left thousands in need of emergency shelter. In Taiwan, 50,000 people are stranded and flooding has submerged many homes. In China nearly 1 million people have been evacuated in the Fujian Province while 13,000 people have been displaced in the Zambales Province in the Philippines with authorities describing the situation as a calamity. Typhoon Morakot has brought with it a record amount of rainfall with close to 2.5 meters falling on Taiwan. So far Shelterbox has deployed 224 boxes to the Philippines and 100 boxes to Taiwan. **Two of those boxes are from our Green Bay Rotary club!**
